<p><sup>1</sup> ASPIRA and Esperanza are smaller, bilingual cyber charters whose students are primarily Philadelphia students whose native language is Spanish. They are very unlike other PA cyber charter schools in several significant ways, and thus excluded from the averages in the bottom two rows of the table.</p> <p><sup>2</sup> Central PA Digital Learning and Susq-Cyber are much smaller cyber charter schools drawing students primarily from small regions of central PA, in contrast to the big nine each of which is larger and draws students from across the Commonwealth. They are excluded from the two rows of averages at the bottom of the table.</p> <p><sup>3</sup> All columns weighted by total cohort size, which is not necessarily proportional to number of students of any specific race, economic, or special education status.</p>
